

What is the New Hampshire Professional Registry?

ACROSS NH, Child Care Aware® of New Hampshire, and the Bureau of Child Development and Head Start Collaboration use the <u>NH Professional Registry</u> that is specifically designed for afterschool and early childhood professionals. In the registry, you will be able to:

- Create a confidential personal online profile that can be accessed and updated anytime, making it easy to create your professional resume
- Search and register for training opportunities with credentialed trainers anywhere in the state
- Track your own training hours and maintain a running record of training. This 'training transcript' is suitable for printing and emailing –certificates from trainings are not needed!

If you are a credentialed Master Professional Workshop Trainer, Faculty or Allied Professional, you will be able to:

- Track your trainings presented through ACROSS NH, Child Care Aware® of New Hampshire; you will learn how to enter trainings presented for other organizations
- View attendance in your upcoming trainings
- Create your transcript for trainings you attended and trainings you presented

If you are credentialed as an Individual Mentor, Program Consultant, or Allied Professional, your colleagues will be able to request your services.

The New Hampshire Professional Registry is overseen by the Child Development Bureau Program Improvement Specialist with a team of ACROSS NH and Child Care Aware® of New Hampshire database administrators, all licensed and trained by Child Care Aware® of America. These professionals are guided by best practices including technology and data confidentiality policies. Personal information entered into the registry will be kept strictly confidential, and registry data may be reported as statistical data only.
